

Your Rights Under Article 25 of the New York General Business Law (NY Fair Credit Reporting Act)

If you reside in New York or are applying for a job located in New York, you are entitled to the following rights under Article 25 of the New York General Business Law:

- You have the right to request the name and address of the consumer reporting agency ("**CRA**") that furnishes your background report.
- You have the right to request a free copy of the consumer report.
- If you believe any information in the report is inaccurate, incomplete, or outdated, you have the right to dispute the information directly with the CRA.
- The CRA must reinvestigate the disputed information and remove or correct any information that is found to be inaccurate, incomplete, or unverifiable.
